Why are we doing this?

In student ministries we want to give our students an opportunity for mission work and service. This will in turn help them grow towards The Lord and each other. Our goal is to love them where they are, but love them too much to let them stay there. Project Shine is now a part of our strategy to help us accomplish our mission to train up fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ that are ready to face the real world and not walk away from their faith in their early 20's.

PROJECTS

Some Project Shine crews will embark on a week long adventure of painting an entire house in one week, with 2 coats of paint. Some crews will work at multiple sites doing any of the following projects: paint or stain a deck, garage paint, yard work, interior painting, hanging drywall or hanging siding, painting the block foundation of a house, etc.

THE BENEFITS OF A WEEK OF PROJECT SHINE

• **Praise and Worship** - Each evening students are led in an exciting and energetic praise and worship service that will uplift them through song and prepare them for a challenging message that they can apply to their lives and grow closer to God.

• Work Ethic - With adult leadership, students will learn about hard work, serving others and special skills such as painting, installing windows and siding, roofing, yard work and paying attention to detail.

• **Teamwork** - Students are placed on work crews with the same students and adults for the entire week thus revealing how God can use them together to accomplish large jobs such as painting a whole house in less than one week.

• **Fun** - Project Shine participants get a day off in the middle of the week for relaxation and fun at a local swim park with slides, volleyball, mini golf, and a picnic. In addition, one evening during the week Project Shine sponsors a community celebration that includes blow up rides, games, crafts and a carnival like atmosphere.

Project Expectations

We are excited to have as many youth and adults participate in Project Shine as possible. Therefore, the "Expectations" are to provide an atmosphere of consistency, unity, and focus to our week. We will rely on each Church's youth leaders to help enforce this reasonable list of guidelines; this will eliminate distractions and keep ALL participants on the same level. We ask that if you have any questions to PLEASE contact a Project Shine leader BEFORE the project week begins.

- 1. Be flexible!
- 2. Have a desire to serve others (not just our residents.)
- 3. Work hard and work safe!
- 4. Show respect to residents, leaders, each other, and all facilities.
- 5. Youth are not permitted to leave and return to Project Shine. If there is an emergency, please contact a Project Shine leader at one of the numbers listed on the front.
- 6. No tank tops, camisoles, or sleeveless t-shirts.
- 7. No skin-tight clothing.
- 8. Must wear proper footwear on worksites must be sneakers or boots that cover the whole foot. (no flip flops or sandals)
- 9. Shorts must be 2-3" from knee length (no rolling up/down shorts and they must be worn at the waist.)
- 10.No personal electronics or cell phones.
- 11.No foul language, sexual joking, gestures, or harassment.
- 12.No alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs or weapons of any kind.
